## INDIAN CONSTITUTION DAY

Constitution Day also known as 'Samvidhan Divas', is celebrated in our country on 26th November every year to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. On 26th November 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India adopted the Constitution of India, which came into effect from 26th January 1950.

On 26<sup>th</sup> Nov 2021, Presentation given by our faculty members on salient features of constitution and awareness about constitutional provisions for welfare of indian citizens.



Ms. Nidhi Khanpara had discussed about total time line of making process of Indian constitution since 1934. She had covered various topics like Cripps India Mission, Cabinet Mission Plan, formation and election process of Constituent Assembly, Nature of Indian Constitution and role of Chairman & committee members of Constituent Assembly. Mr. N. N. Gamit had discussed about Amendments in Indian Constitution. Ms. Dhruti B. Pandya had
